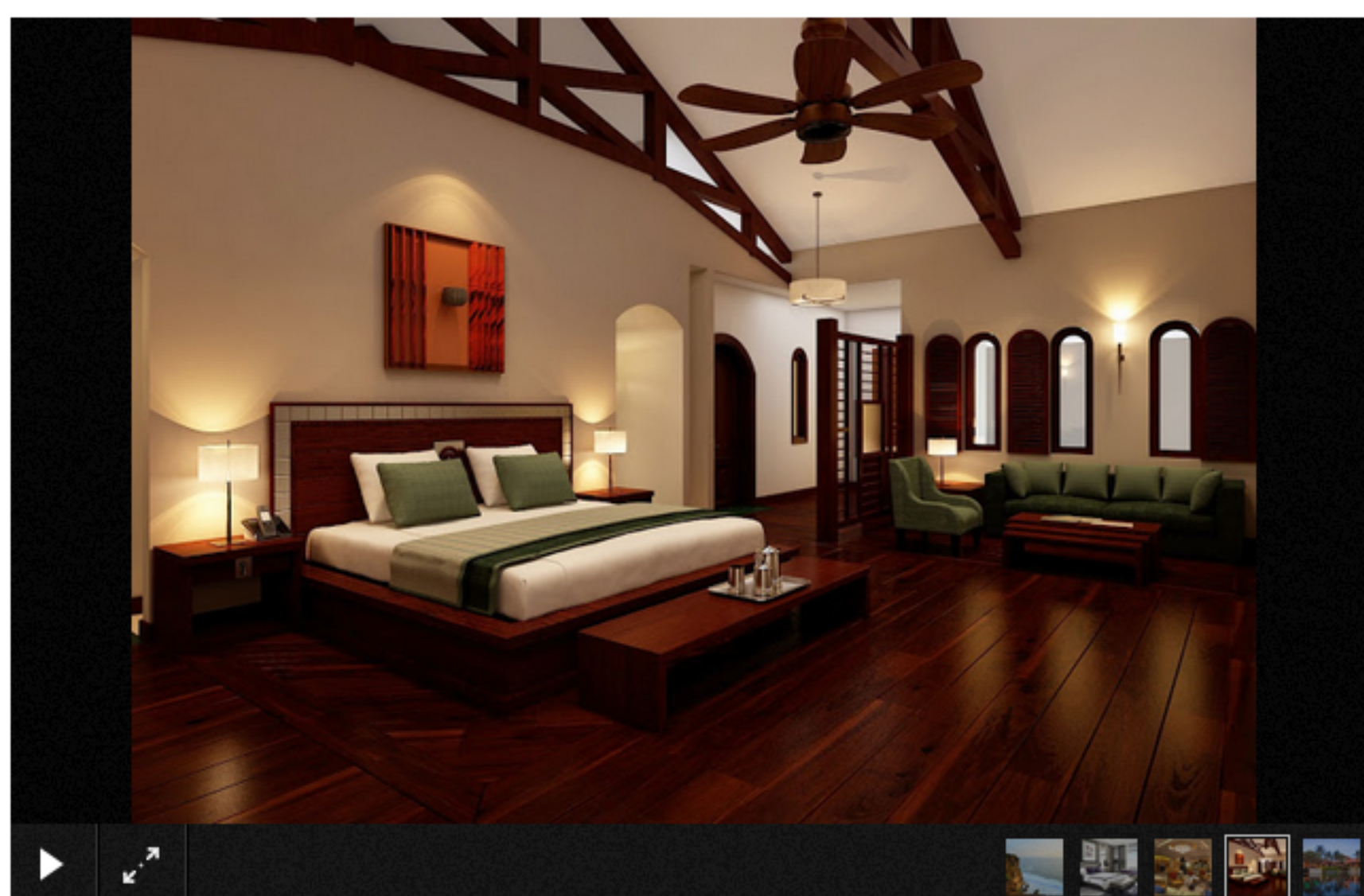


## Southeast Asia's Newest Luxury Hotels and Anticipated Openings (SLIDESHOW)

### The Chedi Club Jimbaran, Bali

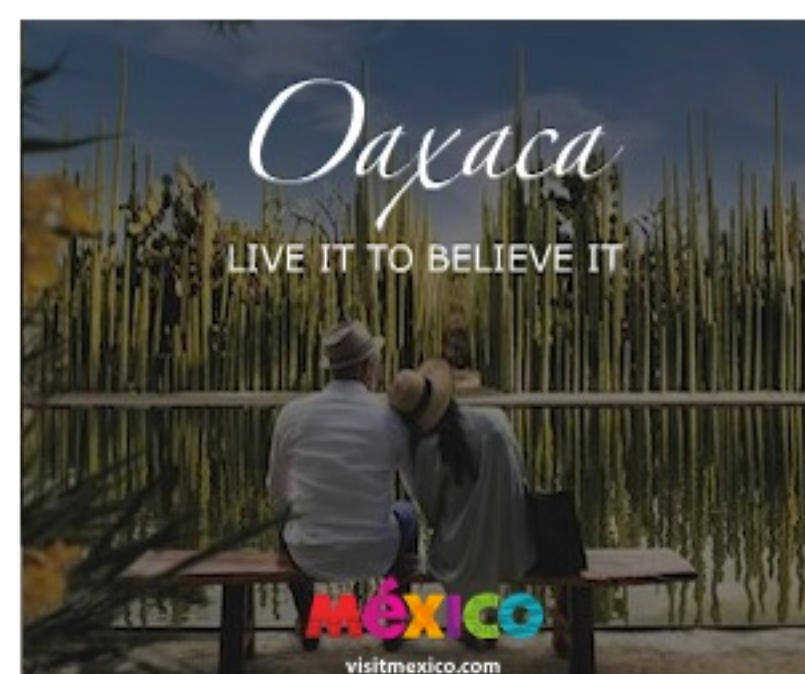
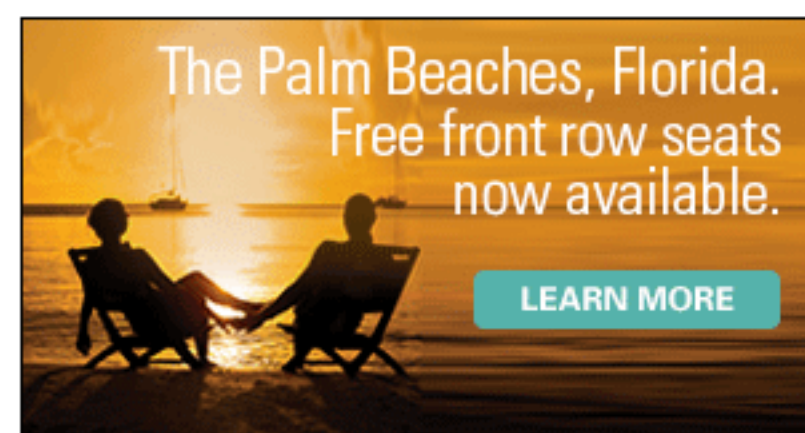
