








Sanctum Inle Resort, Myanmar - hotel review Julia Pearson soaks up the scenery at this five star retreat





Even though the lake is one of Myanmar's main tourist draws, it remains a serene spot in which to relax and enjoy the natural beauty of the surroundings, well away from the country's hectic cities. Whereas much of the accommodation in the area is centred in the dusty town of Nyaungshwe, Sanctum is one of a few hotels on the lake itself, boasting stunning views and a far more relaxed environment than the town, so we'd highly recommend it for the location alone.

as such the hotel industry is having to play catch up fast. In a country mercifully untouched by international chains, many hotels are rundown and vastly overpriced for the standard you'd expect in neighbouring Thailand for example. Sanctum, which opened in 2016, is a bit of a turning point, a genuine five star experience with lush landscaped gardens, cloistered walkways, large modern rooms, slick service, and a beautiful infinity pool overlooking the lake.



off and relax while gazing out at the lake, mountains, hotel gardens and the odd water buffalo. In keeping with the five star ambitions, there's also a gym, spa, a swish restaurant and bar, and even a hotel shop selling local handicrafts.

Although it's tempting to stay put, you'll want to get out on the lake

and explore at some point. Again, the location of Sanctum is perfect

as it has a jetty and direct access onto the lake, meaning you don't have to head into town to hire a boat. We went for a half day

morning excursion which we found ample time, visiting some local villages and markets. The highlight though had to be the Inle Heritage Centre which has a refuge for native breed Burmese cats, all available for cuddles (but only during timed tours so check ahead). The hotel has a fleet of bikes too so you can go off and explore on your own. We took a great trip up to the local Red Mountain Vineyard for sunset - the wine's not amazing but the views certainly are. **Food and Drink**




cuisine too, with varying degrees of authenticity compared to local street food. Amongst the myriad breakfast buffet options, you can try mohingha, the country's famed fish curry and later on, a very good version of Shan chicken noodles as well as tea leaf and tomato salads made from produce grown on the lake's floating gardens. The hotel also serves another local wine, from the Aythaya vineyard, which was actually pretty good. Which Room?

and masses of space. All rooms are very comfy and spacious, however, each with their own private terrace, living area, large en-


suite bathrooms, king size beds and all mod cons, so you really can't go wrong.




